Statistical data from the Grenada Drug Epidemiology Network (GRENDA) indicate that ninety-eight (98) patients were admitted to the Rathdune Psychiatric Unit, Grenada, for problems associated with the consumption of drugs during the period 1 April to 30 June 2013. Ninety-nine (99) patients were admitted to the Unit for the period 1 April to 30 June 2012, with similar medical problems.

Ninety-one (91) males were admitted for each period of 2012 and 2013 under review; 8 females were admitted to the Unit in 2012 and 7 in 2013, for similar medical problems, reported above.

Figure 1 and 2 below present statistics on the number of drug-related admissions to Rathdune Psychiatric Unit, by gender and age range, for the periods January to March 2012 and January to March 2013 respectively.
