The following is a Summary of the Grenada Drug Information Network (GRENDAIN) Statistical Report of Indicators, for the period *1 January to 30 September 2011*. GRENDAIN is the mechanism through which Grenada collects, analyzes, and disseminates information on drugs, for the purpose of monitoring trends, developing policy, and implementing appropriate programmes and responses. Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Drug-Related Offences:

- Six hundred and thirty-three (633) persons were arrested and charged for drug-related offences. (Males: 592; Females: 41)
- Forty-two (42) persons (all males) between ages 15 to 19 years were arrested and charged for drug-related offences.

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Possession Of Drugs Within One Hundred Yards Of A School:

- One (1) person was arrested and charged for possession of drugs within 100 yards of a school.

Number Of Persons Convicted For Drug-Related Offences:

- One-hundred and nineteen (119) persons were convicted for drug-related offences; 116 for possession of drugs; 3 for drug trafficking.

Type And Quantity Of Drugs Seized By The Royal Grenada Police Force:

- Cannabis Plants: 4,649 units
- Cannabis Cigarettes: 2,212 units
- Cannabis: 406.42 kg
- Cocaine: 12.95 kg
- Crack: 391 g

Number Of Criminal Deportees:

- Thirty (30) persons were deported to Grenada for criminal offences. (Males: 29; Females: 1)

Firearms:

- Four (4) firearms were forfeited in relation to drug trafficking. Four persons were arrested for such offence.

Number Of Persons Sentenced To Prisons For Drug-Related Offences:

- Forty-eight (48) persons were sentenced to Prison for drug-related offences. (Males: 46; Females: 2)

Age Range Of Persons Sentenced To Prisons For Drug-Related Offences:

- 15-19 years: 2 persons
- 20-24 years: 7 persons
- 25-29 years: 10 persons
- 30-34 years: 5 persons
- 35-39 years: 7 persons
- 40 years and over: 17 persons

Number Of Patients Admitted To Rathdune Psychiatric Unit For Problems Derived From the Consumption Of Drugs:

- Two hundred and fifty-four (254) persons were admitted to Rathdune Psychiatric Unit. (Males: 240; Females: 14)

Number Of Patients Admitted To General Hospital For Problems Derived From the Consumption Of Drugs:

- One hundred and thirty-seven (137) persons were admitted to the General Hospital. (Males: 122; Females: 15)

Number Of Patients Admitted To Carlton House Treatment Centre For Problems Derived From the Consumption Of Drugs:

- Eleven (11) persons were admitted to Carlton House Treatment Centre. (Males: 10; Females: 1)

Financial Crimes:

- One person was arrested for money laundering offences.
