



GRENDIN STATISTICAL REPORT OF INDICATORS, (SUMMARY)



1 JANUARY TO 31 DECEMBER 2010

The Grenada Drug Information Network (GRENDIN) is the mechanism through which Grenada collects, analyzes, and disseminates information on drugs, and related information, for the purpose of monitoring trends, developing policy, and implementing appropriate programmes and responses. The Network is made up of all institutions which collect drug-related statistics. GRENDIN was established by Cabinet in December 2002.

The Drug Control Secretariat is the National Observatory on Drugs in Grenada. It performs the administrative functions of GRENDIN.

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Drug-Related Offences

- Seven hundred and eighty-three (783) persons were arrested and charged for drug-related offences. (Males: 712; Females: 71)
- Seventy-nine (79) persons twenty years and under were arrested and charged for drug-related offences. (Males: 68; Females: 11)

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Possession Of Drugs Within One Hundred Yards Of Schools

- Two (2) persons (males) were arrested and charged for possession of drugs within a radius of 100 yards of a school.

Type And Quantity Of Drugs Seized By Law Enforcement Officers

- Cannabis plants: 4,741 units
- Marijuana Cigarettes: 1,992 units
- Cannabis (Marijuana): 302.218 kg
- Cocaine: 49.081 kg
- Crack: 639 g
- Cannabis Seeds: 92.29 g

Number Of Criminal Deportees To Grenada

- Thirty-four (34) persons were deported to Grenada for criminal offences. (Males: 30; Females: 4)

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Money Laundering

- No persons were arrested and charged for money laundering offences.

Number Of Persons Sentenced to Prisons For Drug-Related Offences

- Eighty (80) persons were sentenced to prisons for drug-related offences. (Males: 77; Females: 3)
- Ninety-six (96) percent of persons sentenced to prisons for drug-related offences were males and four (4) percent were females.

Age Range & Percentage Of Persons Sentenced To Prisons For Drug-Related Offences

- 15-19 years: 3 persons (4%)
- 20-24 years: 12 persons (15 %)
- 25-29 years: 19 persons (24 %)
- 30-34 years: 9 persons (11%)
- 35-39 years: 15 persons (19 %)
- 40 years and over: 22 persons (27%)

Number Of Patients Admitted To Rathdune Psychiatric Unit For Drug -Related Problems

- Three hundred and seventy-five (375) persons were admitted to Rathdune Psychiatric Unit for drug-related problems .(Males: 360; Females: 15)

Number Of Patients Admitted To General Hospital For Drug -Related Problems

- One hundred and seventy-one (171) persons were admitted to the General Hospital for drug-related problems. (Males: 157; Females: 14)

Number Of Patients Admitted To Carlton House Treatment Centre For Drug-Related Problems

- Thirty-one (31) persons were admitted to Carlton House Treatment Centre. (Males: 24; Females: 7)
