

GRENDIN STATISTICAL REPORT OF INDICATORS (SUMMARY):



1 JANUARY 1988 TO 31 DECEMBER 2010

The Grenada Drug Information Network (GRENDIN) is the mechanism through which Grenada collects, analyzes, and disseminates information on drugs, and related information, for the purpose of monitoring trends, developing policy, and implementing appropriate programmes and responses. The Network is made up of all institutions which collect drug-related statistics. GRENDIN was established by Cabinet in December 2002.

The Drug Control Secretariat is the National Observatory on Drugs in Grenada. It performs the administrative functions of GRENDIN.

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Drug-Related Offences: 1988 - 2010

- Eight thousand, seven hundred and eighty-six (8,786) persons were arrested and charged for drug-related offences. (Males: 8,141; Females: 645)
- One thousand, two hundred and sixty-six (1,266) persons twenty years and under were arrested and charged. (Males: 1, 121; Females: 145)

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Possession Of Drugs Within One Hundred Yards Of Schools: 1998 – 2010

• Twenty (20) persons were arrested and charged for possession of drugs within 100 yards of school.

Type And Quantity Of Drugs Seized By The Royal Grenada Police Force: 1988 - 2010

• Cannabis Trees: 318,953 units

Marijuana Cigarettes: 34,069 units

• Marijuana: 10,469.84 kg

• Cocaine: 1,158.78 kg

• Crack: 15.824 kg

• Ecstasy: 3, 338 units

• Methamphetamines: 89 units

Number Of Criminal Deportees: 1995 – 2010

• Four hundred and seventeen (417) persons were deported to Grenada for criminal offences. (Males: 391; Females: 26)

Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Money Laundering: 2004 – 2010

 Seventeen (17) persons were arrested and charged for offences related to money laundering.

Number Of Persons Imprisoned For Drug-Related Offences: 1988 - 2010

- One thousand, seven hundred and forty-seven (1,747) persons were imprisoned for drug-related offences. (Males: 1,667; Females: 80)
- Ninety-five (95) percent of persons convicted to prisons for drug-related imprisonment were males and five (5) percent were females.

Age Range Of Persons Imprisoned For Drug-Related Offences: 1988 - 2010

• 15-19 years: 63 inmates (3 %)

• 20-24 years: 255 inmates (15 %)

• 25-29 years: 332 inmates (19 %)

• 30-34 years: 372 inmates (21%)

• 35-39 years: 360 inmates (21 %)

• 40 years and over: 363 (21 %)

Number Of Patients Admitted To Rathdune Psychiatric Unit For Drug Abuse: 2003 – 2010

• Two thousand, five hundred and nine (2,509) persons were admitted to Rathdune Psychiatric Unit for drug abuse. (Males: 2,389; Females: 120)

Number Of Patients Admitted To General Hospital For Drug Abuse: 2003 – 2010

• Nine hundred and eighty-four (984) persons were admitted to the General Hospital. (Males 850; Females: 134)

Number Of Patients Admitted To Carlton House Treatment Centre For Drug Abuse: 1988 - 2010

• One thousand and sixty-seven (1,067) persons were admitted to Carlton House Treatment Centre. (Males: 987; Females: 80).
