



**SUMMARY:**  
**GRENDA STATISTICAL**  
**REPORT OF INDICATORS,**  
**1 JANUARY TO 31 DECEMBER 2009**



The Grenada Drug Information Network (GRENDA) is the mechanism through which Grenada coordinates the collection and dissemination of drug-related statistical information.

GRENDA is comprised of all institutions involved in the implementation of the national drug control program. It was established in 2002.

The Drug Control Secretariat, which is the National Observatory on Drugs in Grenada, performs the administrative functions of GRENDA.

**Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Drug-Related Offences**

- Seven hundred and nineteen (719) persons were arrested and charged for drug-related offences. (Males: 670; Females: 49)
- Ninety-six (96) persons twenty years and under were arrested and charged. (Males: 89; Females: 7)

**Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Possession Of Drugs Within One Hundred Yards Of Schools**

- Three (3) persons were arrested and charged for possession of drugs within a radius of 100 yards of a school.

**Type And Quantity Of Drugs Seized By Law Enforcement Officers**

- Cannabis plants: 13,502 units
- Marijuana Cigarettes: 2,470 units
- Marijuana: 226.79 kg
- Cocaine: 109.09 kg
- Crack: 741 g

**Number Of Criminal Deportees To Grenada**

- Forty-four (44) persons were deported to Grenada for criminal offences. (Males: 39; Females: 5)

**Number Of Persons Arrested And Charged For Money Laundering**

- Seven (7) persons arrested and charged for money laundering offences.

**Number Of Persons Sentenced to Prisons For Drug-Related Offences**

- Seventy-eight (78) persons were imprisoned for drug-related offences. (Males: 68; Females: 10)
- Eighty-seven (87) percent of persons convicted to prisons for drug-related imprisonment were males and thirteen (13) percent were females.

**Age Range & Percentage Of Persons Imprisoned For Drug-Related Offences**

- 15-19 years: 1 person (1 %)
- 20-24 years: 9 persons (12 %)
- 25-29 years: 11 persons (14 %)
- 30-34 years: 11 persons (14%)
- 35-39 years: 9 persons (12 %)
- 40 years and over: 37 persons (47%)

**Number Of Patients Admitted To Rathdune Psychiatric Unit For Drug Abuse-Related Problems**

- Two hundred and eighty-two (282) persons were admitted to Rathdune Psychiatric Unit for drug abuse. (Males: 268; Females: 14)

**Number Of Patients Admitted To General Hospital For Drug Abuse-Related Problems**

- Two hundred and forty-four (244) persons were admitted to the General Hospital. (Males: 210; Females: 34)

**Number Of Patients Admitted To Carlton House Treatment Centre For Drug Abuse**

- Twenty-one (21) persons were admitted to Carlton House Treatment Centre. (Males: 19; Females: 2)
