The Drug Control Secretariat through its biennial collection of drug information has sourced data from the Criminal Investigations Department, Royal Grenada Police Force, on the number of people deported to Grenada for the period 1 January to 30 June 2015. The data provided in the tables below indicate the countries of deportation and the age range and sex of the deportees.

Analyses of the data indicate that a total of twelve (12) males were deported to Grenada. They were mainly deported from the United States of America (USA). The majority of the deportees were over the age of forty.
