The fourth and final edition of the GRENDEN Fact Sheet for the year 2017 provide a summary of Alcoholrelated Comorbidity and Mortality at the General Hospital Grenada; for the period 1 January to 31 December, during the years 2015 to 2017.

Over that three-year period there were twenty (20) incidences of alcohol comorbidity and mortality reported. Nineteen (19) individuals were above the age of forty. This information was provided by the Medical Records Office at the General Hospital, St. Georges, Grenada.
