



# GRENDEN FACT SHEET

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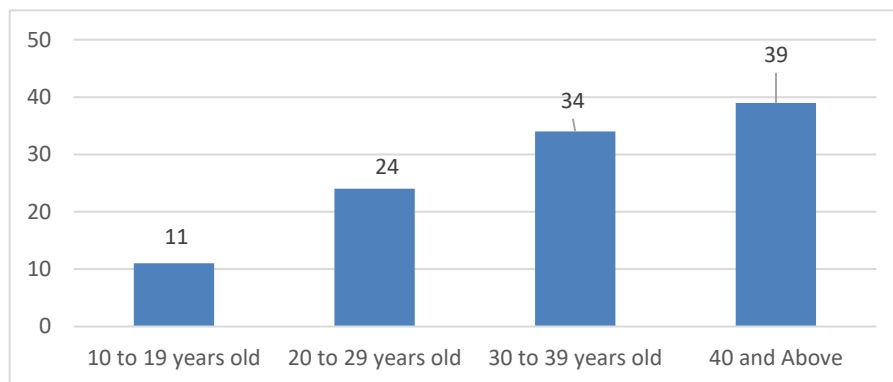
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The data presented in this second edition of the GRENDEN Fact Sheet for 2017, provides a statistical summary of the number of individuals accessing treatment at the Rathdune Psychiatric Unit and the Carlton House Drug Rehabilitation Centre, for health-related problems arising from the use of drugs. The data was collected for the period 1 January to 31 December, 2016. A total of 108 individuals received treatment during the period under review. The data shows that 101 males and 7 females received treatment.
